All-neighborhood garage sale in June

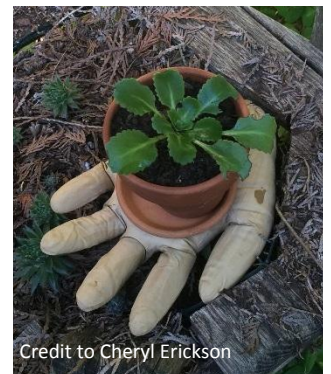
