Parking Guidelines

The board has been informed of multiple incidents in the neighborhood stemming from parking of cars along the roadway. These have included blocking of emergency vehicles and garbage trucks on cul-de-sacs and near miss interactions between traffic, parked cars and pedestrians.

We are recommending the following guidelines for the safety of all and also in the interest of maximizing the appeal and attractiveness of our neighborhood.

- Park vehicles on your property and not on the street as a general rule.
- When it's necessary to park on the street, ensure cars are pulled completely off the roadway, especially on main roads and on cul-de-sac circles.
- Keep marked pedestrian lanes clear of vehicles.
- Avoid pick up or drop off of Serene Lake Elementary students on the east end of the neighborhood – it's disruptive to the people who live there and unsafe for through traffic.
